Chapter I

General provisions

§ 1

Department of International Relations of the State University College of Applied Sciences in Chełm and the Polish Geopolitical Society, Branch in Chełm in cooperation with:

- Department of Political Science and International Relations of the Lviv Polytechnic National University,
- Department of International Relations, Information and Regional Studies of the National Aviation University in Kyiv,
- Department of International Relations of the Vasyl Stefanyk Precarpathian National University in Ivano-Frankivsk

and

 Student Scientific Club of International Relations of the State University of Applied Sciences in Chelm.

organize the "International Geopolitical Essay Competition", hereinafter referred to as the *Competition*.

§ 2

The aim of the Competition is:

- 1) popularization of geopolitics among students and secondary school students;
- 2) developing interests in broadly understood knowledge examining the impact of geographical factors on the foreign policy of states and their groupings and on the formation of international order and security;
- 3) developing the ability to use various sources regarding geopolitics;
- 4) promotion of the organizer and co-organizers.













The participants of the Competition may be students of all Polish and Ukrainian universities, as well as students of secondary schools from Poland.

§ 4

- 1. The competition involves writing an essay in Polish, Ukrainian or English on one of the following topics:
- The Baltic Sea in NATO's security strategy;
- The importance of secret services in creating political elites in Eastern European countries:
- Donald Trump's geopolitical vision of the world on the eve of the US presidential elections;
- Arab states towards the war between Israel and Hamas;
- The political and military dimension of chemical weapons;
- Russian war crimes in Ukraine judge, settle, punish;
- Geopolitical consequences of Finland's membership in NATO;
- Geopolitical codes of contemporary Russian imperialism;
- Mercenary troops in contemporary armed conflicts.
- 2. Participation in the Competition is free of charge.
- 3. Only works that have not been published in print anywhere before will take part in the Competition and not submitted in other competitions.
- 4. The number of participants in the Competition is a maximum 70 (in total in the pupils/students category). The competition is a one-stage competition.
- 5. The essay should be sent electronically to isurowiec@panschelm.edu.pl as a PDF file, with the annotation "Essay competition" in the title of the message. The deadline for submitting works is **April 12, 2024** at 23.59. It is the responsibility of the submitter to ensure that the essay has been successfully delivered to the recipient.
- 6. A participant may submit only one competition entry. Applications are accepted until the limit of places is filled. Each work will be assessed by two reviewers.
- 7. The competition commission is responsible for organizing the competition, it consist of:

- 8. The competition results will be announced no later than April 30, 2024.
- 9. Information about the results of the Competition will be available at panschelm.edu.pl/konkursptg_sm
- 10. Competition participants will be notified of the results via e-mail and the Competition website: panschelm.edu.pl/konkursptg_sm
- 11. Winners have the right to collect prizes and diplomas in person.

- 1. The Competition organizers provide prizes for the winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd place, separately in the pupils/students category): for taking 1st place a cash prize, for taking 2nd and 3rd place material and book prizes. All Competition Participants will receive diplomas.
- 2. The winners of the Competition may be those who obtain the highest number of points determined by the Competition Committee.
- 3. 10 best Competition Participants (total in the pupils/students category) will be qualified to the second stage of the 6th edition of the International Geopolitical Olympiad organized by the Polish Geopolitical Society, without having to participate in the first stage of the Olympiad, but provided they express written consent to participate in the Olympiad.
- 4. The Organizers are not responsible for copyright infringement by the Competition Participants. This responsibility rests with the Competition Participants.
- 5. Competition works will be encoded after being sent to the organizers and will be verified in the anti-plagiarism system. If a copyright infringement is found, the work will be disqualified and will not be assessed (Appendix No. 2).

§ 6

- 1. The work must be prepared in a text editor, Times New Roman (font size 12, margins 2.5 cm, line spacing 1.5).
- 2. The length of the text cannot exceed 10 typewritten pages. It is possible to send the work by post or in an electronic version as a PDF file to the address isurowiec@panschelm.edu.pl, e-mail title: Essay competition.
- 3. The title page template is included in Annex 1 to these Regulations.













- 4. Together with the essay, please send an application form and a statement on the processing of personal data (Appendix No. 3).
- 5. The bibliography should be arranged alphabetically.

- 1. - 2. - 3. Personal data will be processed based on the consent of the Competition participant.
- 4. The Polish Geopolitical Society and the State University College of Applied Sciences in Chełm process personal data for the purposes of organizing and conducting the Competition, providing information on the results of the Competition, awarding prizes and diplomas, in order to fulfill tax and accounting obligations, as well as for marketing and archival purposes.
- 5. Providing personal data by the competition participant is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the competition.
- 6. Personal data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the above-mentioned purposes.
- 7. The data will not be made available to third parties, except for cases provided for by law or when the Polish Geopolitical Society and the State University College of Applied Sciences in Chełm entrust third parties with the processing of this data.
- 8. Competition Participants have the right to access personal data, the right to request rectification of their data, the right to request the deletion of their data, the right to limit the processing of their personal data, the right to transfer their personal data and the right to withdraw consent to their processing at any time.
- 9. Withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
- 10. The Competition Participant has the right to file a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office regarding unlawful processing of personal data.
- 11. Personal data will not be subject to decisions based solely on automated processing, including profiling.
- 12. All participating in the Competition consent to the processing of personal data by PANS in Chełm in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) in the scope related to the conduct of the Competition.













- 1. Minors are obliged to obtain the consent of their parents or legal guardians to participate in the competition.
- 2. The Polish Geopolitical Society and the State Academy of Applied Sciences in Chełm reserve the right to publish the names, surnames and information about the Competition participants.

- 4. The organizers have the right to cancel the Competition without giving a reason and not to select the winners.
- 5. We reserve the right to change these Regulations during the Competition.
- 6. The Competition Organizers have the exclusive right to resolve disputes arising during the Competition and to interpret these Regulations.
